
Why Does Job Suffer?

"The 'goel' stood for another to defend his cause, or avenge wrongs done to him... to acquit him of all charges... He was a defender of the oppressed, a champion of the suffering, and advocate of the accused. If you were ever wronged, the "goel" stood beside you... The word is important in Old Testament jurisprudence, having both a criminal and civil aspect. As 'blood avenger,' a goel had a responsibility to avenge the blood of a slain kinsman. He sought not revenge but justice. On the civil side he was a redeemer or vindicator. He had the responsibility to 'buy back'—or redeem—the lost inheritance of a deceased relative... As such he was the defender or champion of the oppressed."
