The DEATH of SAUL and HIS SONS

1 SAM. 31:1-2: **“The Philistines fought against Israel... [they] killed Jonathan, Abinadab, and Malchishua, Saul’s sons.”**

VS. 3: **“The battle became fierce against Saul. The archers hit him, and he was severely wounded...”**

VS 6: **“Saul, his three sons, his armorbearer, and all his men died together that same day.”**



2nd SAM. 1:11-12: **“[David] took hold of his... clothes and tore them... [he] mourned and wept and fasted...”**

SET-UP for 2nd SAMUEL:

The 'SONG of the BOW'

2. SAM. 1:17-27: **"The beauty of Israel is slain on your high places! How the mighty have fallen! - The bow of Jonathan did not turn back... the sword of Saul did not return empty. Saul and Jonathan were beloved and pleasant in their lives, and in their death they were not divided... O daughters of Israel, weep over Saul... How the mighty have fallen in the midst of the battle! -- How the mighty have fallen, and the weapons of war perished!"**



1 SAM. 2:4: **"The bows of the mighty men are broken, And those who stumbled are girded with strength."**

AN IRONIC END:

1 SAM. 15:12: **“Now go and attack Amalek, and utterly destroy all that they have, and do not spare them. But kill both man and woman, infant and nursing child, ox and sheep, camel and donkey.”**

1 SAM. 15:9: **“But Saul and the people spared [king] Agag... and were unwilling to utterly destroy them...”**

2 SAM. 1:8-10: **“And [Saul] said to me, ‘Who are you?’ So I answered him, ‘I am an Amalekite.’ [Saul] said to me, ‘Please stand over me and kill me... So I stood over him and killed him...”**

THE BOOK of 2nd SAMUEL:

David's Initial Reign

2 SAM. 2:4: **“Then the men of Judah came, and there they anointed David king over the house of Judah.”**

2 SAM. 2:8-10: **“But Abner... commander of Saul’s army, took Ishbosheth the son of Saul and... made him king... over all Israel... and he reigned two years. Only the house of Judah followed David.”**

2 SAM. 3:1: **“there was a long war between the house of Saul and the house of David. But David grew stronger and stronger, and the house of Saul grew weaker and weaker.”**

You did it secretly, but I will do this thing before all Israel...”**

“God warns David that because he troubled another man’s house, God will allow trouble to come upon his own house - from within [his] house. In these judgments, David will reap what he has sown - with interest.” (David Guzik)

→ **ISAAC** → **JACOB** → **JUDAH** (Rev. 5:5)

“THE DAVIDIC COVENANT”

Wherever I have moved about with all the children of Israel, have I ever spoken a word to anyone from the tribes of Israel... saying, ‘Why have you not built Me a house of cedar?’”

“THE DAVIDIC COVENANT”

2 SAM. 7:11(b)-13: "Also the *LORD* tells you that He will make you a house (= 'royal dynasty')."

"When your days are fulfilled and you rest with your fathers, I will set up your seed after you, who will come from your body, and I will establish his kingdom. He shall build a house for My name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever."

“THE DAVIDIC COVENANT”

2 SAM. 7:18: “King David went in and sat before the LORD; and he said: ‘Who am I, O Lord GOD? And what is my house, that You have brought me this far?’”

“THE DAVIDIC COVENANT”

ACTS 2:29-31: “Men and brethren, let me speak [to you] freely of the patriarch David... [who] being a prophet...” – “and knowing that God had sworn... that of the fruit of his body, according to the flesh, He would raise up the Christ to sit on his throne, [David], **foreseeing this, spoke concerning the resurrection of the Christ...**”

“When God promised to establish an everlasting kingdom and raise up one of David’s sons to sit on the throne of the kingdom, he was talking in one sense about Solomon... and in another sense, about the resurrection, ascension, and enthronement of Messiah. David was a prophet to whom God revealed these things; thus, [David] understood the double fulfillment aspect of [this] promise.”

2 SAM. 24:3: **“Joab said to the king... why does my lord the king desire this thing?”**

VS. 4: **“Nevertheless, the king’s word prevailed against Joab and against the captains of the army. Therefore Joab and the captains of the army went out from the presence of the king to count the people of Israel.”**

1st Chronicles 21:7: **“God was displeased with this thing; therefore He struck Israel. [And] So David said to God, “I have sinned greatly, because I have done this thing...”**
