JOSHUA FLOWS into JUDGES:

Joshua 24:31: "Israel served the LORD all the days of Joshua, and all the days of the elders who outlived Joshua, who had known all the works of the LORD which He had done for Israel."

Judges 2:7: "So the people served the LORD all the days of Joshua, and all the days of the elders who outlived Joshua, who had seen all the great works of the LORD which He had done for Israel."

Judges 1:1: "Now after the death of Joshua it came to pass..."

JOSHUA has DIED:

Judges 1:1: **“Now after the death of Joshua it came to pass...”**

Judges 2:8: **“Now Joshua the son of Nun, the servant of the **LORD**, died when he was one hundred and ten years old.”**

Joshua 2:10: **“When all that generation had been gathered to their fathers, another generation arose after them who did not know the **LORD** nor the work which He had done for Israel.”**

Joshua 2:11: **“Then the children of Israel did evil in the sight of the **LORD**...”**

JOSHUA has DIED | The TIME of the JUDGES:

"Judges is one of the saddest books in the Bible, telling, as it does, of repeated apostasy, chastisement, and mercy. Rebellion, retribution, repentance, and rest, are the dominating notes in this minor music. Joshua treats of the heavenly, but Judges of the earthly; the one is of the Spirit, and the other of the flesh. In one is a song of joy, and the other a sob of sorrow. In one is victory, and the other, defeat. In one is [the] progress [of the nation], and in the other, decline: in the one, faith, and... the other, unbelief: in the one [is] freedom, and in the other bondage. Judges teaches us—on the one hand—not to presume, but on the other hand, not to despair."

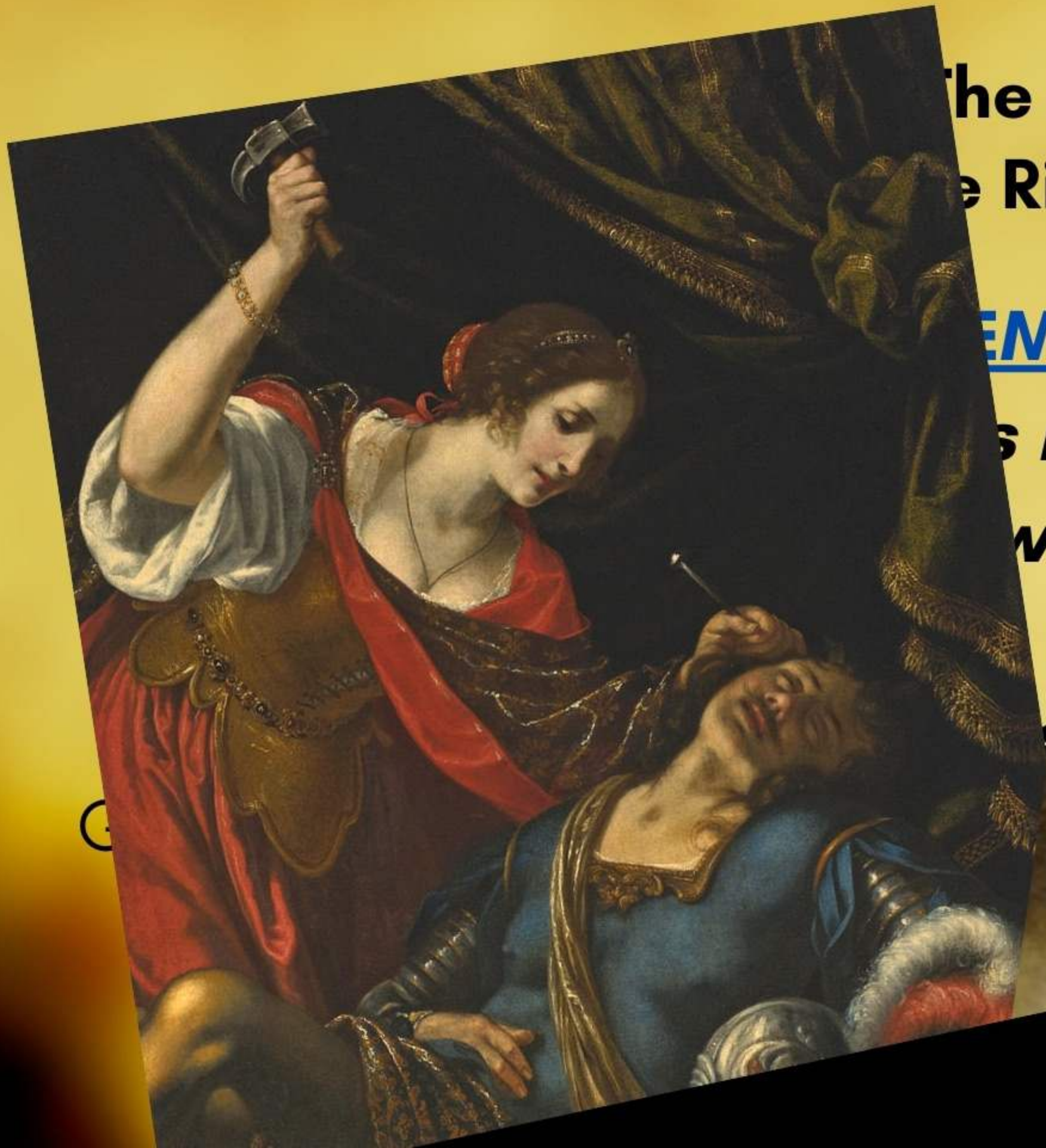

HEROES of the BIBLE:

- 2nd Samuel 23:20: **"Benaiah... killed two lion-like heroes of Moab. He also [went] down and killed a lion in the midst of a pit on a snowy day."**
- **David & Goliath**
- 1 Chronicles 12:8: **"...mighty men of valor, men trained for battle, who could handle shield and spear, whose faces were like the faces of lions, and were as swift as gazelles on the mountains..."**
- 1 Chronicles 12:33: **"fifty thousand... who went out to battle, expert in war with all weapons of war, stouthearted men who could keep ranks..."**
- 1 Chronicles 20: **Sibbechai, Elhanan, Jonathan - "Giant Killers"**

Psalm 18:29: **"By You I can run
against a troop... BY MY
GOD... I can leap
over a wall!"**



HEROES of the BIBLE:

- **“The spirit of the Lord came upon”** Othniel—in Judges 3:10—and enables him to defeat the Mesopotamians...
- Judges 6:34 says the Spirit of the Lord **CLOTHED HIMSELF with Gideon** to defeat the Midianites...
- Judges 11:29 says **the Spirit of the Lord equipped Jephthah** to defeat the Ammonites...
- **“The Spirit of the LORD began to move”** in Samson in Chapter 13... and **CAME UPON HIM MIGHTILY to...** tear a LION APART... to KILL 30 men of Ashkelon, to **BREAK HIS BONDS** in Chapter 15...

“the LORD was WITH the judge”
“Spirit of the Lord”
(7 Times in Judges!)



THE POWER of the SPIRIT and US:

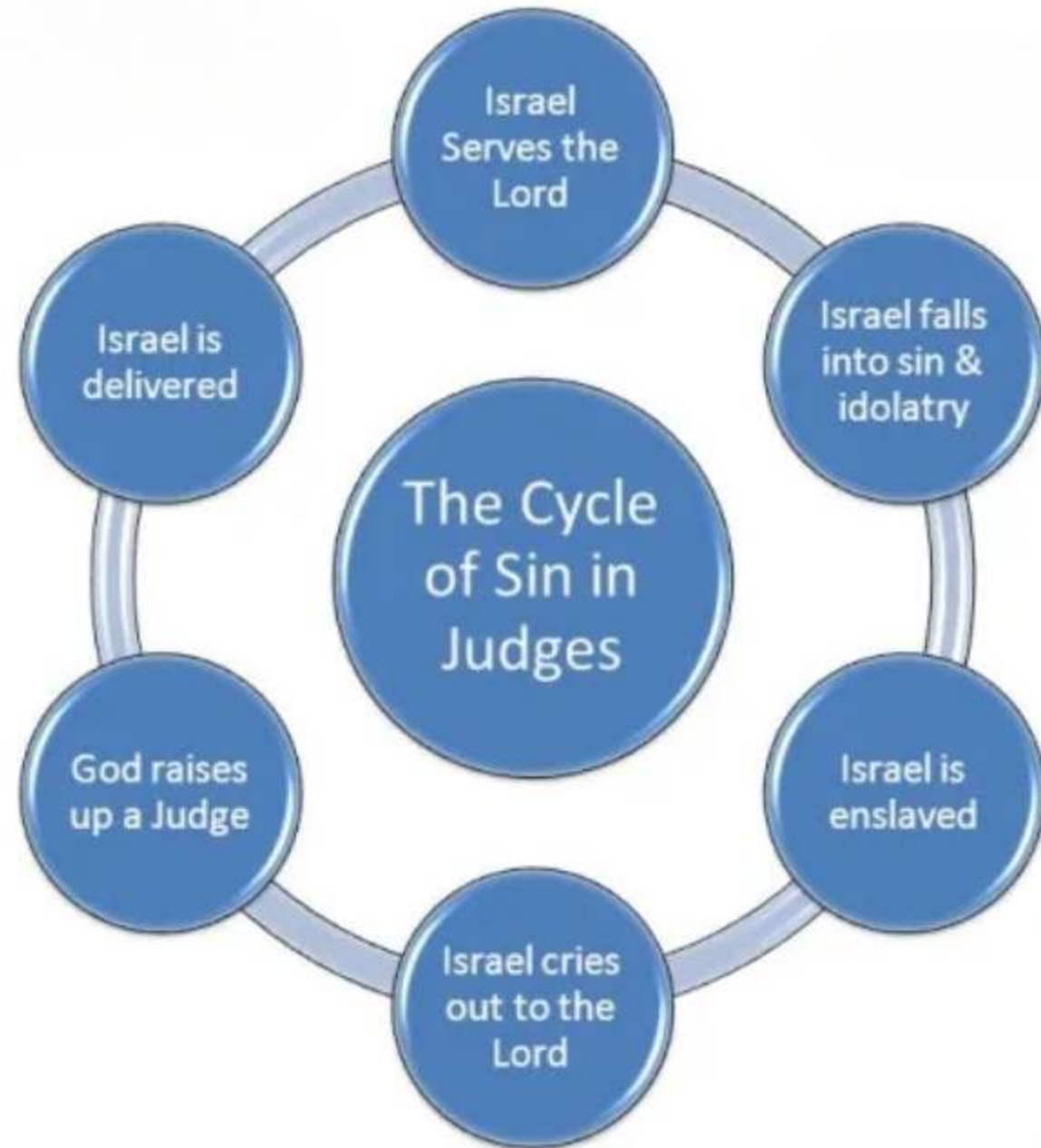

THE REPEATING PATTERN of JUDGES:

Summarized in Judges 2:7-23

VS. 7: "The people served the LORD all the days of Joshua, and all the days of the elders who outlived Joshua..."

VS. 8: "Joshua... died when he was one hundred and ten years old."

VS. 10: "When all that generation had been gathered to their fathers, another generation arose after them who did NOT know the LORD nor the work which He had done for Israel." –

VS. 11: "Then the children of Israel did evil in the sight of the LORD..."



THE REPEATING PATTERN of JUDGES:

Summarized in Judges 2:7-23

VS. 11-14: “[They] served the Baals; and they forsook the LORD God of their fathers, who had brought them out of the land of Egypt; and they followed other gods from among the gods of the people who were all around them... they bowed down to them; and they provoked the LORD to anger. They forsook the LORD and served Baal and the Ashtoreths.”



THE REPEATING PATTERN of JUDGES:

Summarized in Judges 2:7-23

VS. 14-15: “[So] the anger of the LORD was hot against Israel. [And] He delivered them into the hands of plunderers who despoiled them; and He sold them into the hands of their enemies all around, so that they could no longer stand before their enemies. Wherever they went out, the hand of the LORD was against them for calamity, as the LORD had said, and as the LORD had sworn to them. And they were greatly distressed.”



THE REPEATING PATTERN of JUDGES:

Summarized in Judges 2:7-23

VS. 16–17: “Nevertheless, the LORD raised up judges who delivered them out of the hand of those who plundered them. Yet they would not listen to their judges... they played the harlot with other gods, and bowed down to them. They turned quickly from the way in which their fathers walked, in obeying the commandments of the LORD; they did not do so.”



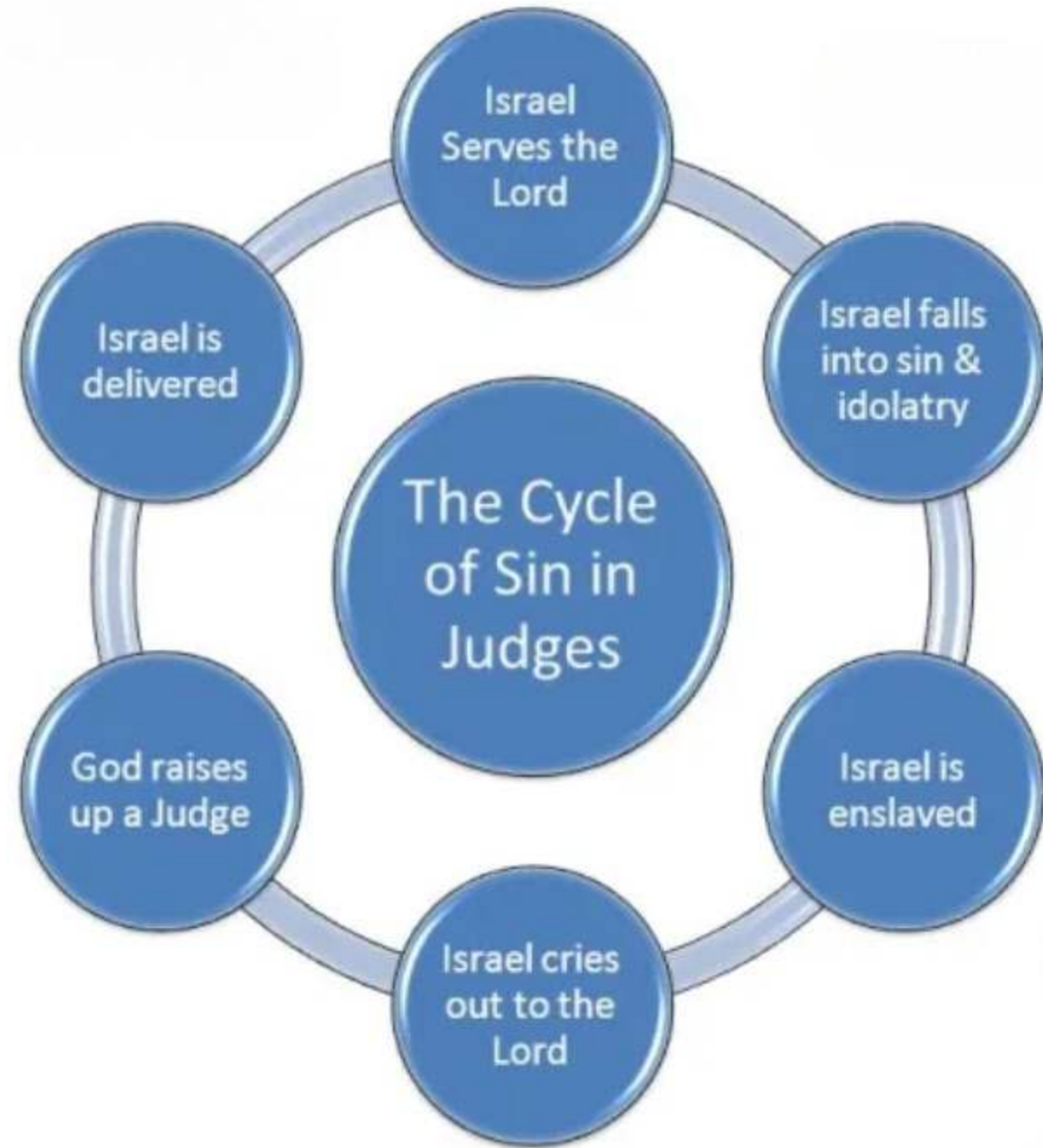
THE REPEATING PATTERN of JUDGES:

Summarized in Judges 2:7-23

VS. 18-19: “And when the LORD raised up judges for them, the LORD was with the judge and delivered them out of the hand of their enemies all the days of the judge; for the LORD was moved to pity by their groaning because of those who oppressed them and harassed them. And it came to pass, when the judge was dead, that they reverted and behaved more corruptly than their fathers, by following other gods, to serve them and bow down to them. They did not cease from their own doings nor from their stubborn way.”

Warrior, Priest, or Prophet

MAJOR JUDGES: Othniel, Ehud, Deborah, Gideon, Jephthah, and Samson...

MINOR JUDGES: Shamgar, Tola, Jair, Ibzan, Elon, and Abdon...

"The thirteenth, Abimelech, is included in neither group, since his story is... a continuation of... Gideon's, and his career is... deplorable..." (BibleHub.com)

WARRIOR-Judge: Ex. Gideon and Samson

PRIEST-Judge: Ex. Eli

PROPHET-Judge: Ex. Samuel

- **A PROLOGUE (Chapters 1–3)** - *“the historical scene for the narrative...”*
- **THE MAIN BODY (Chapters 3–16)** - *“the recurring pattern within Israel’s history.”*
- **AN EPILOGUE (Chapters 17–21)**

Chapter 17 & 18: ‘The Danite Migration’ (**RELIGIOUS CORRUPTION**)

Chapters 19 – 21: ‘The War Against Benjamin’ (**POLITICAL CORRUPTION**)

“The purpose of these stories is to illustrate the consequences of Israel’s apostasy and anarchy.”

CONCLUDING STATEMENT: **“there was no king in Israel; everyone did what was right in his own eyes” (Judges 21:25)**

THE BACK-STORY to JUDGES:

EX. 23:20-33: “Behold, I send an Angel before you to keep you in the way and to bring you into the place which I have prepared... My Angel will go before you and bring you in to the Amorites and the Hittites and the Perizzites and the Canaanites and the Hivites and the Jebusites; and I will cut them off...”

“You shall not bow down to their gods, nor serve them, nor do according to their works; but you shall utterly overthrow them and completely break down their sacred pillars... I will send My fear before you, I will cause confusion among... the people to whom you come, and will make all your enemies turn their backs to you... I will send hornets before you, which shall drive [them] out... I will not drive them out... in one year... [But] Little by little I will drive them out from before you, until you have increased, and... inherit the land.”

THE BACK-STORY to JUDGES:

EX. 23:30: “...**I will drive them out from before you...**”

Numbers 33:50–56: “**When you have crossed the Jordan into the land of Canaan... then you shall drive out all the inhabitants of the land from before you, destroy all their engraved stones, destroy all their molded images, and demolish all their high places; you shall dispossess the inhabitants of the land and dwell in it, [Because] I have given you the land to possess...**”

THE BACK-STORY to JUDGES:

Numbers 33:55-56: 'But if you do not drive out the inhabitants of the land from before you, then it shall be that those whom you let remain shall be irritants in your eyes and thorns in your sides, and they shall harass you in the land where you dwell. Moreover it shall be that I will do to you as I thought to do to them.' "

The Incomplete Conquest of the Land!

JUDGES 1:27: **"Manasseh did not drive out the inhabitants of Beth Shean and its villages, or Taanach and its villages, or the inhabitants of Dor and its villages, or the inhabitants of Ibleam and its villages, or the inhabitants of Megiddo and its villages; [because] the Canaanites were determined to dwell in that land.**

VERSE 28: **"It came to pass, when Israel was strong, that they put the Canaanites under tribute, but did not completely drive them out."**

VERSE 29: **"Ephraim [did not] drive out the Canaanites who dwelt in Gezer..."**

VERSE 30: **"Nor did Zebulun drive out the inhabitants of Kitron or the inhabitants of Nahalol; so the Canaanites dwelt among them, and were put under tribute."**

VERSE 31: **"Nor did Asher drive out the inhabitants of Acco or the inhabitants of Sidon, or of Ahlab, Achzib, Helbah, Aphik, or Rehob..."**

VERSE 33: **"Nor did Naphtali drive out the inhabitants of Beth Shemesh or the inhabitants of Beth Anath..."**

ROMANS 1:18-32:

“Although they knew God, they did not glorify Him as God, nor were thankful, but became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened... and changed the glory of the incorruptible God into an image made like corruptible man... Therefore God also gave them up to uncleanness, in the lusts of their hearts, to dishonor their bodies among themselves, who exchanged the truth of God for the lie, and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator... For this reason God gave them up to vile passions. For even their women exchanged the natural use for what is against nature...

ROMANS 1:18-32:

“Likewise also the men, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust for one another, men with men committing what is shameful... And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a debased mind, to do those things which are not fitting; being filled with all unrighteousness, sexual immorality, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, evil-mindedness; whisperers, backbiters, haters of God, violent, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things...”
